



ReelzChannel® Picks Albuquerque Studios As New State-of-the-Art Corporate HQ in "Hollywood Southwest"

Albuquerque, NM (February 12) - ReelzChannel® -- TV About Movies(TM), has chosen the state-of-the-art Albuquerque Studios for its new corporate headquarters located in New Mexico's "Hollywood Southwest." The network has signed a lease for 30,000 square feet of office and production space, making it the largest long-term tenant at the illustrious facility. The studio has been home to many top film and television productions since 2007, including *Terminator Salvation: The Future Begins*, *Game*, *The Spirit*, *Breaking Bad* and *In Plain Sight*.

Build-out of the studio's office and technical spaces will begin immediately, with a design from Albuquerque-based architecture firm Dekker/Perich/Sabatini. Construction will be managed by Klinger Constructors and will be completed just months after the network's plans to relocate were announced. The target move-in date is May 1, 2009, when ReelzChannel's programming, production, Web development, creative services, marketing and communications divisions all will be housed and operated out of one location for the first time.

Albuquerque Studios - Opened in mid-2007, Albuquerque Studios (www.abqstudios.com) is a purpose-built motion picture and television production facility in Albuquerque, New Mexico and includes some of the largest and tallest stages ever built outside of Hollywood. Its 28-acre campus is comprised of 8 world-class soundstages totaling 168,000 square feet, 100,000 square feet of mill / production support space and 100,000 square feet of full service production office space. Soundstages are paired, allowing clients to open two 18,000 sf stages to one, large 36,000 sf as well as open two 24,000 sf stages to one, massive 48,000 sf soundstage 55 feet to the grid. The studio hosts production on campus and supports production all over the southwest with the help of a full suite of production support departments and partner companies. Albuquerque Studios also acts as facilities manager for the City of Albuquerque-owned historic Santa Fe Railyard facility in downtown Albuquerque for all entertainment related business.
